Harold Trujillo joined Bible League International in 2007 as a trainer for U.S. Hispanic Ministries. Later, he went on to become the Training Coordinator for Midwest U.S. Ministries. Today, as a Master Trainer Facilitator, he trains local churches, denominations, and others throughout the Midwest in Bible League's proven evangelism and church planting methods. He also serves as a program liaison between Bible League and church planters in the U.S. and around the world.

Born and raised in Colombia, South America, Harold moved to New York City in 1985. After relocating to Chicago, he worked in the financial sector for 18 years. During that time, he felt God tugging on his heart. Harold followed the Lord's call and returned to school. He received the Bachelor of Arts in Bible and Theology from Moody Bible Institute in 2002. In 2015, he earned the Master of Arts in Biblical Studies from Moody Theological Seminary. He was awarded a Doctoral Degree Honoris Causa in Divinity from India's Himachal Bible College and Seminary in 2019.

Harold has been instrumental in growing Bible League's U.S. Spanish language ministry. Certified by the State of Illinois as a Spanish-language interpreter and translator, he has assisted in translating the ministry's Church Planter Training materials. He also helped to facilitate a successful partnership with the Bible Society of Brazil.

"I do this work because I am grateful to God for salvation. I don't consider this a job, but rather a ministry. It is an opportunity to serve the Lord, and I do it gladly," he explains. With a special place in his heart for prisoners, Harold is active in Bible League's prison ministry. He has led *Project Philip* Bible study training and Church Planter Training with prisoners behind bars.

In addition to his training responsibilities, Harold, an accomplished photographer, is an Associate Pastor for Spanish Ministries in Berwyn, Illinois. He has also served as a youth pastor and church leader, overseeing small group Bible studies and planting several churches in the Chicagoland area.
