- Over the next year, people in more than 12 countries in Africa will engage in God's Word through *Project Philip* Bible studies, Church Planter Training, and Bible-based Literacy classes.
- Through *Project Philip* Bible studies, the Gospel of Jesus Christ is reaching people in seven regions in Ghana, including Volta, Western, and Northern. Bible League's Church Planter Training is equipping believers to share God's Word in Ghana's North-East and Northern Regions.
- More than half the population of Ghana is under the age of 25. And though English is the official language, not everyone speaks it. There are around 80 languages used throughout the country.

Week 1: Pray for God to open doors for churches in Ghana to engage hundreds of thousands of children in God's Word. Believers are grateful for a new opportunity that could make this a reality. May God direct them as they continue to plan for this promising outreach.
