- This year, more than 38,000 people in Europe have already studied God's Word through Bible League's *Project Philip* Bible studies and Church Planter Training. Praise God for this incredible work!
- Two-thirds of the people reached in Albania and Armenia are children and youth. Parents and other family members often hear the Gospel when their children join *Project Philip* Bible studies.
- Over half of Albania's population is Muslim. And even though the nation of Armenia was the first one to adopt Christianity, many there still don't have a personal relationship with Christ. People throughout this region desperately need the Good News.

Pray for Europe

Week 1: Intercede for peace in Artsakh (Nagorno-Karabakh) and Armenia. Although border regions are especially dangerous, home groups and Bible studies continue meeting. Bible League-trained Bible study leaders and church planters are serving faithfully, despite the danger. Ask God to provide strength and protection to all those who live and serve there. Pray for a peaceful resolution to the conflict. Ask God to comfort families whose loved ones are away from home.

Pray for a local ministry that works with children in northern Albania. Recently, they started *Project Philip* Bible studies with about 100 teenagers and children. Pray that these young people grow in understanding God's Word, and that the families learn about Jesus through them.

Pray for Europe (continued)

Week 2: Pray for the third module of Church Planter Training taking place in Kotayk Province, Armenia. Ask the Lord to bless the trainees and facilitators and use them for His glory. Pray for the safety of five trainees from the Artsakh region.

Praise the Lord for a local church in Tirana, Albania, that is using Bible League's *Project Philip* Bible studies for a summer camp for children and youth. Pray that as the participants study God's Word, they discover Jesus Christ as their Savior.

Week 3: Pray for the evangelism concerts that recently took place in 10 Albanian cities. Hundreds of people heard the Gospel. So far, 265 of them have shown interest in learning more about Jesus. Pray that local churches follow up with these individuals using Bible League's *Project Philip* Bible study materials. Let us pray that God would open people's hearts to the Good News. Thank God for opportunities to share His precious Word with people in countries such as Bulgaria, Lithuania, North Macedonia, and Serbia. Pray that God opens doors to introduce Bible League's *Project Philip* Bible studies to these countries in the future.

Week 4: Praise God for a shipment of 10,000 Bibles received earlier this year in Croatia. Many of the Croatian easy-to-read Bibles have already found their way into churches and people's hands. Pray that these Bibles help local churches to share the Good News in Croatia.

Pray for the war in Ukraine to end, as the situation continues to affect the surrounding countries, particularly Albania. Since Albania already suffers economically, the war has made life for believers and churches there increasingly difficult. Pray for renewed hope for those living in Albania, and that God would draw people to faith in Jesus. Ask Him to bless the efforts of local churches as they conduct outreach campaigns.
