
Freed from his addictions, José craved just one thing—to share that grace with others. Bible League's Church Planter Training helped him.

2023 YEAR IN REVIEW

Bible League's strategic initiatives focus on who we reach through our evangelism and discipleship Bible study programs (adults, children, and youth) and the additional ways we reach them (through Church Planter Training, Prison Ministry, and Bible-based Literacy). He has called us to share His Word and grow His Church. Together with you, we bring Him honor and glory as we serve Him around the world. Let's give God all thanks and praise for the great things He has done...

- More than 40% of the nearly 2.9 million people reached with the Gospel were children and youth. Bible League's new *Discovery Series* materials were instrumental in reaching these young people.
- In Tanzania, Bible League-trained leaders reached more than 47,000 youth with the Gospel. In one town, Christians used school sporting events in their ministry. After playing sports like soccer and volleyball, students gather in small groups at lunch to study God's Word. Many were raised Muslim or with no faith at all. But thanks to your help, they now follow Jesus.
- The impact of Church Planter Training in 2023 is evidence of the growing global hunger for God's Word. Bible League-trained church planters established nearly 2,700 new churches, a 65% increase over 2022. Praise God! Most of these new churches were in Asia (1,335) and Africa (836).
- Church planters served people of all ages, especially children.
 They know that this is critical in reaching the adults in their communities. In Sri Lanka, church planters made a breakthrough in reaching workers from strong Hindu backgrounds. These new believers now want their own children to be firmly rooted in God's Word.
- Teaching people to read and write using God's Word offers a way to reach people with the Gospel who otherwise wouldn't have the opportunity to hear it. In 2023, Bible League-trained leaders in 16 countries used Bible-based Literacy to share the Gospel with nearly 49,000 people, a 34% increase over 2022.

Almost 28,400 of those reached were in eight Asian countries that fiercely oppose Christianity, including Bangladesh and India.

- God's Word touched the hearts and lives of nearly 130,000 inmates in 31 countries through Bible League's prison discipleship studies—a 32% increase over 2022! The 52 lessons specifically relate to those behind bars and are included in our easy-to-read prison Bible.
- The mayor of a violence-plagued city in Colombia recently heeded some important advice: "Look for people who teach the Word of God in dangerous neighborhoods, police stations, and prisons." He called Bible League. In response, three church planters shared the Good News with prison inmates there and planted several churches inside those prisons.
- In countries where Christians face persecution, God opened hearts to His Word and grew His Church. Nearly 875,000 people in 21 persecuted lands found hope and strength in the Word of God—222,000 more than in 2022.
- In Bangladesh, Hindu women from one Santal tribal community embraced the life-changing Word of God. Although they face intense opposition for their faith, God's Word has deeply affected their lives. Today, these women are steadily drawing closer to Christ. You're part of their stories...and so many more. Thank you!
