WEEK 1

Give God thanks for the 40 participants who recently completed a Bible League Bible study in Shinyanga, **Tanzania**. Each one received a Bible of their very own.

Praise the Lord for how He is working in prisons across **Nepal**. Two inmates in a prison in the

central part of the country recently accepted Jesus. In another nearby prison, five prisoners are taking part in a church fellowship and Bible-based Literacy classes. Pray that they will continue to grow in Christ. Pray, too, that prison ministries in other parts of the country will flourish, and that many prisoners will come to Christ.

WEEK 2

Pray for Benjamin, a Bible League-trained church planter working among the Urao indigenous people in **Bangladesh**. He recently baptized five new believers. Pray that they will grow daily in Christ and boldly share their testimonies with others.

Please ask God to protect churches and Bible League partners in **Syria**. We received a report that terrorists attacked a church in Damascus on Sunday, June 22, killing 20 people and injuring more than 60. Pray for peace in Syria. Pray, too, that this tragic event may be a reason for the glory of God and Christ to be revealed in the hearts of people there.

WEEK 3

Praise God for the new children's *Discovery Series* Bible study group at a church in **Hong Kong**. Thirty-three children from a nearby community are taking part.

Bible League's team in **Armenia** reports that two partner churches recently wrapped up

summer camps for children and youth. They used Bible League Bible studies to plant the seeds of God's Word in more than 150 young hearts and lives. In addition to reaching the kids, God's Word also reached many parents. Pray that the Lord will grow the seeds of His Word in their hearts.

WEEK 4

Praise God! Bible League South Africa recently received long-awaited approval to hold Bible studies inside of 200 correctional centers in that country. On July 10, the team gathered with prison officials and volunteers at the Department of Correctional Services headquarters in Pretoria. Our team trained the others on how to share our Bible studies with inmates. We expect to roll out the program before the end of the year. Pray that God's Word will bear much fruit behind bars.

U.S. Ministry volunteers who serve as Bible study trainers in local churches will gather at Bible League's headquarters in Crete, IL, on September 25-26. The two-day summit will offer the trainers a refresher course and time for fellowship. Pray for smooth logistics and for every detail to be covered. Pray that these days will be a powerful time for those God has called to serve.
