WEEK 1

Anti-Christian extremists in a village in eastern **India** recently killed a family—husband, wife, and their daughter—because of their faith in Christ. Pray that these persecutions will stop so that believers will be safe. Ask God to change the hearts of the persecutors.

Bible League Bible studies and English language Bible-based Literacy lessons are reaching prison inmates in five areas of **Nepal**—Nuwakot, Hetauda, Dhankuta, Damauli, and Bhadrapur. Pray that many prisoners will accept Jesus.

WEEK 2

Pray for ongoing ministry in churches and schools in **Kenya**. Pray for those who are sharing God's Word and for those who are receiving it. Pray that the Holy Spirit will bring lasting transformation into their lives and communities.

Pray for Bible League-trained planter Rafael and his newly planted church in Pasto, **Colombia**. God is opening doors

for them to bring His Word to those most in need in their community.

Bible League's team in **South Sudan** will soon train Sunday school teachers how to use the *Discovery Series*. Pray that these new children's materials will make an impact in young lives and give glory to God.

WEEK 3

Praise God for Dipali, a Bible League-trained leader in **Bangladesh** who has started a Bengali language Bible-based Literacy class with Hindu women in her area. Please pray that the Holy Spirit will open the hearts of these women as they learn to read and write. Pray that they will receive Jesus as their Savior and connect with the local church.

Special forces in **Haiti**'s Croix-des-Bouquets community have recently been fighting against armed groups there. Residents are scared, but churches were still holding worship services. Pray for an end to this cycle of violence.

WEEK 4

Praise God for the growing relationships Bible League is building with diverse ethnic Christian leaders and churches across the **U.S.**, including the Hmong Church. We thank the Lord for the unity, trust, and shared commitment to advancing the Gospel among all nations and communities.

Pray for Pastor Ravi in **India** who is using Bible League's Bible study materials. He's currently leading a small group with 10 people; 5 have accepted Christ and were baptized in early February. Pray for those in the group and the new believers to grow spiritually.
